

## **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS ABOUT YOUR DIABETES MEDICATIONS**

### **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

### **STOP TAKING SGLT-2 INHIBITORS BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE**

You are currently taking a type of diabetes medication called an **SGLT-2 inhibitor**. These medications help lower blood sugar by removing extra glucose through your urine.

**You MUST stop taking these medications 3 days before your scheduled procedure**

### **SGLT-2 INHIBITOR MEDICATIONS INCLUDE:**

- **Canagliflozin** (Invokana)
- **Dapagliflozin** (Farxiga)
- **Empagliflozin** (Jardiance)
- **Ertugliflozin** (Steglatro)
- **Bexagliflozin** (Brenzavvy)
- **Sotagliflozin** (Inpefa)
- **Synjardy** (empagliflozin/metformin)
